

VII. PESTICIDES AND METHODS OF APPLICATION		
ADULT CONTROL: <i>Anvil 10+10 ULV applied via truck-mounted ULV foggers to control adult mosquitoes within the central Florida area. Rate of application is 2.5 oz/min @ 10mph with a variable-flow unit set to apply between 5 to 19mph. Use appears consistent with labeled directions.</i>		
LARVAL CONTROL: <i>5% Skeeter Abate applied via backpacks and helicopter to areas of standing water in central Florida at a rate of 5 lbs/acre. Use is to control mosquito larvae. Use appears consistent with labeled directions.</i>
